What is the HELP Program all about?

HELP is a community-based organization and is not a government agency.

The Housing Emergency Loan Program (HELP) is a community-based revolving loan fund.

The program provides interest-free loans to people living in poverty in the City of Hamilton. The loans assist recipients in maintaining housing. Loans are available for last month's rent, purchasing use stoves and fridges or to help with moving costs.

Loans are available to people who are without savings and who cannot get a regular loan from a financial institution due to poor credit rating.

All loans are interest free and all recipients are expected to pay them back. By repaying their loans, loan recipients help the next person.

Who Benefits from HELP?

- Loans help recipients to move into affordable housing.
- Allows recipients to establish a credit rating.
- Teaches responsible social behaviour.
