Purpose

Housing Help Centre - Hamilton & Area is a non-profit social service agency that acts as a portal to housing services. The Centre provides information, advocacy and support to people who need housing, especially people with low incomes and people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

Services

- Access and find housing
- 2. Access financial supports to maintain housing including housing allowances, housing stability support and utility support payments
- 3. Navigate housing resources and supports and providing referrals to community services
- 4. Housing retention and eviction prevention support
- 5. Complete subsidized housing applications
- 6. Understand tenant and landlord rights

Landlord Engagement Program

Provides specialized assistance to landlords and housing providers including assistance to landlords experiencing tenancy issues, education and guidance on legislated standards and landlord rights and responsibilities, as well as help to identify resources and access support & financial assistance to maintain tenancies.

Community Development

Support community-based research on housing issues including: Addressing local housing problems; Promoting public awareness and public education; Advocating for improvements in housing solutions.

Financial Support Programs

Housing Stability Program & Rent Ready Program - Assists eligible ODSP and low-income individuals and families maintain housing.

Rental Arrears - Helps make restitution with rental arrears if served with an N4 eviction notice. Utility Arrears Support - Helps individuals and families facing utility disconnection due to arrears.

- One-to-one support focuses on your specific needs. Our case managers connect you with helpful community services and resources. We also advocate on your behalf with landlords and social service agencies.
- **One-to-one support** provides you with the tools you need to stabilize your housing situation and prevent future housing loss.

The SIF supports individuals and families with complex needs or who are involved with or would benefit from services across a variety of sectors including employment, education, mental health and social supports. The SIF provides information for community support services and helps clients access wraparound supports to increase their housing stability.
